



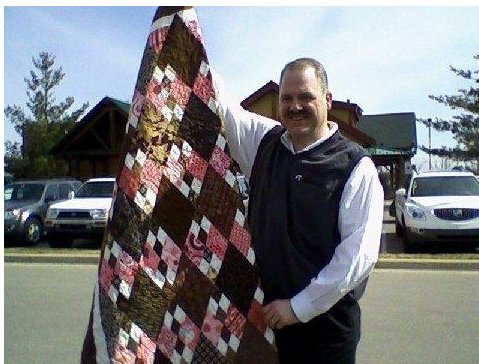

4. Labels must have:
  - Your name
  - Quilt name
  - Quilt size
