WHERE: HOLIDAY INN IN OKEMOS
TIME: 9:00 AM, Friday, January 8, through
 6:00 PM, Sunday, January 10, 2016



COST OF RETREAT ONLY - \$70.00 (includes cost of the sewing room, dinner on Saturday and lunch on Sunday)

COST OF HOTEL ROOM – You can stay at the Holiday Inn Express (has a pool) or the Comfort Inn (does not have a pool). The Comfort Inn is connected to the conference center so you don't have to go outside to get to the sewing room.

Remember it is January and the weather might be bad.

Holiday Inn Express- \$104.94 per night (includes all taxes and fees). This price is for up to two people per room. If you add a third or fourth person it is an additional \$8.00 a night per person. Call the Holiday Inn at 517-349-8700 to reserve your room. Be sure to mention you are an LAP member.

Comfort Inn- \$94.34 per night. Call 517-347-6690 to reserve your room. Be sure to mention you are a LAP member.

RETREAT ACTIVITIES

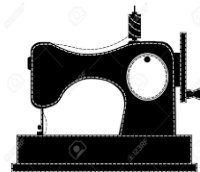
(Ironing Boards and Irons will be provided. Coffee/Tea will be available in the am, with water service all day)

FRIDAY - LUNCH is on your own (brown bag or eat out).

- FRIDAY EVENING **POTLUCK**-Beginning at 6:30 p.m., we are having a potluck. Bring your favorite potluck food to share as well as your own drink. Table service provided.
- GARAGE SALE - Bring garage sale items (priced with your name on them) and share with fellow quilters.
- BABY MYSTERY QUILT (**New-optional!**) - Work on your baby mystery quilt. Details will be given at LAP meetings.

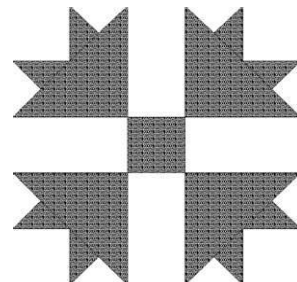
