

“QUILT” GUILD BINGO, March 2018

You all know how to play Bingo. Instead of numbers, we use colors and patterns.

Fabric styles to choose from:

Polka Dots, Christmas, Plaid, Stars, Animals, Batiks, Stripes, Halloween, Paisley, Solids, Flowers, Hearts.

Q (BLUE) Looking thru your stash choose any 5 of the above styles in BLUE. Cut them in 2 1/2 inch squares. Sew them together in a vertical strip (think bingo card) in any order you choose. Set aside.

U (RED) Do the same as above with your RED fabrics. With the blue on the left and the yellow /orange on the right, sew the two strips together. Set aside.

I (YELLOW/ORANGE) Choose only 4 fabric styles for the center strip. Sew two together, then a square of any white fabric then two more YELLOW/ORANGE squares. This will be the center of our bingo card. Sew this onto the RED strip.

L (GREEN) 5 fabrics in any style from your GREEN stash. Sew this strip onto the YELLOW/ORANGE strip.

T (PURPLE/PINK) Do your final strip as you did rows Q, U, I, L, & T. Sew it into the PURPLE/PINK strip. Now you have a “QUILT” Bingo card! Bring a little bag of buttons, or bingo chips or whatever you want to use to keep track of what is called during the game. Prizes will be awarded. After the game, squares will be collected and sewn into a charity quilt.
