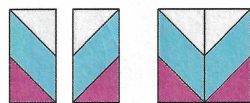


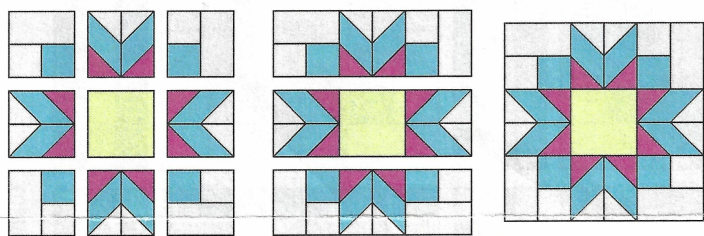
C LUE 6, ASSEMBLY

Assembly Instructions:

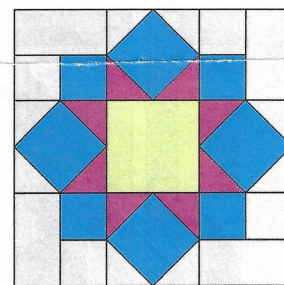
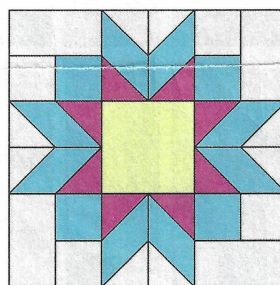
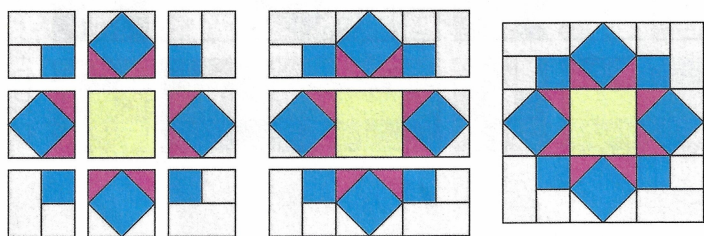
1. Working with the clipped corner units created in Clue 5, stitch the mirror image rectangles together to form a square measuring 4 ½" including seam allowance. Make 24.



2. Using the clipped corner units, the units containing Fabric A from Clue #2, and the 4 ½" square of Fabric C. Arrange the pieces to form the block as shown below. Stitch the pieces together, first in rows, pressing the seams in alternating directions. Stitch the rows together to form the completed block. Press. Your assembled block will measure 12 ½" including seam allowance. Make 6.



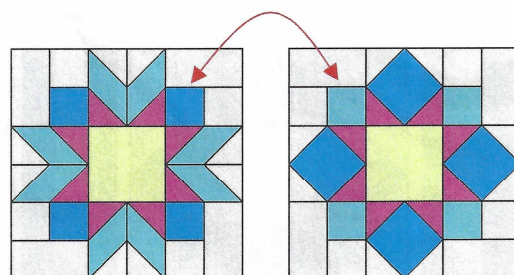
3. Arrange the square in a square units, the units from Clue #2 with the B fabric and the 4 ½" squares of Fabric C as shown below. Stitch the block together, first in rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions. Stitch the rows together to form the completed block. Press. Your assembled block will measure 12 ½" including seam allowance. Make 6.



4. Arrange the completed blocks with the sashing and cornerstones as shown in the layout diagram. Alternate the quilt blocks to form a checkerboard. Turn the pieced sashing strips so that the blocks containing Fabric A are sashed with Fabric B and the blocks containing Fabric B are sashed with Fabric A.

5. Stitch the quilt top together in rows, pressing the seams toward the sashing strips. Stitch the rows together to form the completed top. Press the seams to one side.

Enjoy!



Just for fun, try swapping the corner units between the blocks to see the difference it makes in your layout!
