

November Blotto Block (Block Lottery)

For our November meeting we would like all interested members, to make Jenny Doan's Disappearing Pinwheel #5 block. All who submit their name to me, Judy Heckathorn, by email, will be in the drawing to win these blocks. This makes up a beautiful quilt.

Materials:

One 10 inch square of neutral fabric (white, beige or cream)

One 10 inch square of blue fabric

Try to be very accurate with the sizing of your squares and seams. Put fabric right sides together.

Sew a quarter inch seam along all four sides.

Cut your square across both diagonals. This will give you four half square triangles. Press to the dark fabric. If your cutting was accurate, you should have four squares that are the same size.

Sew these four squares into a pinwheel.

Measure 2 1/8 inches from the right of center and cut the length of the block.

Measure 2 1/8 inches from the left of center and cut the length of the block.

Leaving the center in place, turn the right and left pieces upside down and sew block together. Viola it is done.

It looks really hard but it is very simple.

Please note your new block is NOT a square. It is a rectangle. This quilt will only be able to be put together in one way, with the blocks side by side.

The directions for this block is on Jenny Doan's tutorials. Make sure it is Disappearing Pinwheel # 5.

The drawing for these blocks will be at the November meeting of all names submitted. If you make the block but don't want to win please let me know. If there are a lot of entries we could have more than one winner. Blocks should be mailed or dropped off at the home of the winner.
