I am not making 2 inch triangles; I am making 3/4 inch triangles. Not only am I challenging myself with 3/4 inch triangles, I am testing my brain. For me paper piecing means thinking in reverse, upside down, or any way else you want to label it. Brain health is the new thing, and sewing is a great way to keep our brains healthy. However, spatially and following directions, I flunk. The other day, I spent 45 minutes and 3 attempts assembling a 16 block pattern with 3/4 inch triangles. Let's just say, I had to remake the triangles because there wasn't much left after reverse sewing 3 times. My brain needs a rest after all that!
