It is understood that the judge would need at least 35 quilts to take part in order for voting to take place. *(It was also decided that the results will only be shared with the individual quilter, and no one else, including the board. A list of quilts will be provided at a future guild meeting so that quilters can indicate whether they want their quilts judged or not).*

**Passed:** The guild will allow death and illness information to be published in the LAP Newsletter, if the Sunshine Chair has received the member's permission. *(It was also discussed that if a newsletter isn't going to be published around the time of the notice, a group email notice may be sent to the membership instead).*


The Executive Board met on December 21, 2009, resulting in the following:

### **Hanging your quilt at the LAP quilt show?**

1. A sleeve on your quilt is not necessary.
2. Place your quilt label on the back side in either lower corner.
3. A pillow case is needed for each quilt.
4. Attach a label to the pillow case with the following information. This must match your quilt label.
  - a. Your name
  - b. Name of your quilt (optional)
  - c. Size of your quilt - width and length in inches
