Janie will post the clues on our website (Members Only Section) after each meeting. The reveal will be at the December potluck. We will have until February to finish the quilts. Finished size needs to be 74 x 90. We are asking for volunteers who would be willing to machine quilt them for members who cannot. This is an ambitious project for our guild but the rewards are enormous.
